



DET CRC Postgraduate Student Internships

The DET CRC Education & Training Committee is offering financial support of up to \$5,000 for postgraduate student internships. These internships are available for DET CRC-supported postgraduate students to work outside of their host institutions within DET CRC projects. The objectives of this program are to:

- enhance collaboration, intellectual exchange and networking within the CRC;
- enhance links between research providers and industry sponsors of DET CRC;
- enhance the student research experience within DET CRC, including better access to research facilities and networks; and,
- increase the exposure of DET CRC Participants and Affiliates to postgraduates that may become future employees.

Potential host organisations include industry, government or research Participants or Affiliates of DET CRC. It is anticipated that internships will be for approximately four weeks duration, however, any duration will be considered by the Education & Training Committee who will assess applications. Financial support is intended primarily to support travel and living expenses associated with the internship. Internships that are shorter in duration than four weeks and/or do not require travel/living away from home are likely to be supported at an amount less than \$5,000.

Payment will be provided to the successful student applicants. Interns will be required to write a brief report for the DET CRC newsletter and website communicating the outcomes of their internship.

Applicants are expected to discuss details of the internship with their supervisors, potential internship supervisors and project leaders. The scheme is intended to be flexible rather than prescriptive and the Education & Training Committee welcomes innovative proposals. Applicants are also encouraged to discuss their proposals with a member of the Education and Training Committee.
